SUBJECT: Smoking

NUMBER: 4:29

1. Effective November 19, 1992, smoking is prohibited in all buildings or portions thereof owned, leased or occupied by the Board of Regents except that universities may permit smoking in portions of facilities which are occupied as residences. Smoking may not be permitted in the common areas of dormitories or other multi-unit residences. For the purposes of this section, common areas include, without restriction: elevators, restrooms, laundry rooms, recreation rooms, lobbies, corridors, stairways and building entrances and exits. Signs shall be posted at all entrance and exit ways of facilities stating the facility is smoke-free and that smoking is prohibited. Institutions are permitted to designate outdoor smoking areas.

2. Smoking is prohibited in the facilities and on the grounds of the South Dakota School for the Blind and Visually Impaired and of the South Dakota School for the Deaf.
