SUBJECT: Tuition and Fees: Self-Support Tuition

NUMBER: 5:5:2

1. Self-Support Tuition

All courses offered off-campus will be at self-support tuition rates established by the Board unless state-support rates have been specifically authorized by the Board.

- A. Standard Self-Support Tuition Rates:** The Board sets tuition rates each spring that are effective for the following summer, fall and spring terms. This rate is comprised of the self-support tuition rate plus a component equivalent to the resident state-support tuition HEFF contribution, or 20 percent of the resident tuition rate for undergraduate and graduates respectively, and a surcharge for the support of the Electronic University Consortium (EUC).
- B. Per Credit Hour Rates:** The self-support tuition rates are per credit hour rates for undergraduate and graduate students. There is no distinction between resident and non-resident students as with state-support tuition.
- C. Remedial On-Campus Courses:** These courses will be assessed the undergraduate self-support tuition rate.

2. Self-Support Reduced Tuition Programs

Legislated and Board approved tuition and fee reductions and waivers apply only to state-supported courses and programs except where noted below. (SDCL § 13-55-23)

- A. Reduced Tuition Benefit for South Dakota National Guard Members (SDCL 33-6-5):** The undergraduate and graduate self-support tuition rates assessed to members of the South Dakota National Guard will be reduced by the tuition benefit provided on state-support courses, the adjustment being one-half of the resident state-support tuition rate. This benefit is available because the cost is being covered by funds appropriated to the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs.
