SUBJECT: Room and Meal Service for Special Groups

NUMBER: 6:8

Institutions under the control of the Board of Regents have a primary responsibility to provide lodging accommodations for full-time students. Only limited responsibility exists to provide rooms and meal service for other individuals participating in university sponsored events. Individuals, students from other universities and colleges, and groups having special and compelling reasons for being housed and fed on campus may be accommodated when appropriate.

Institutional officials shall not exert influence on special groups to use the institution's food service or housing facilities in preference to those of privately-operated lodging and eating establishments. However, when special events and large congregations of out-of-town visitors warrant, university facilities may be used. In these instances administrators shall, in all cases, cooperate with representatives of the lodging and food industries and/or the local chambers of commerce.
