

Guidelines for Assessing Course Lab Fees

1. The Laboratory Fee may be assessed on all courses with instructional method type "L" and "K" with CIP codes in the basic and applied sciences, engineering, and technology fields.
2. The Laboratory Fee may be assessed on computer science courses and management information system courses (CIP series 11.0000 to 11.9999, 14.0901, 14.0903, 27.0303 and 52.1201) where there is direct use by student of computers and management information system software in a laboratory setting.
3. The Laboratory Fee may be assessed on "J" instructional method type in specific CIP code areas where equipment and material are expended.
4. The Laboratory Fee may be assessed on all courses with instructional method type A in the fields of art (CIP series 50.0701, 50.0702, 50.0705-50.0711, 13.1302), theatre (CIP series 50.0502 and 50.0507), design and applied arts (CIP series 11.0301, 11.0801, 11.0803, 50.0401, 50.0402, 50.0404, 50.0406-50.0408), photography (CIP series 50.0602, 50.0605), landscape architecture (CIP series 4.0601), journalism/mass communication (CIP series 9.0402, 9.0404, 9.0701, 9.0702, 9.0903, 9.0904, 9.9999, 10.0105, 10.0303, 10.0304, 10.0305, 10.0308), apparel merchandizing (CIP series 19.0901) where equipment and material are expended.
