

Guidelines for Shared Courses

(approved AAC; March 2004)

Shared Courses

1. A shared course is one that is provided by one Regental university with approval for the course to one or more other Regental universities that do not have approval for the course.
2. The receiving Regental institution(s) will offer the shared course as a Topics course (x92) at the same level of the approved course.
3. The receiving Regental institution(s) will use an appropriate prefix for the Topics courses and the title of the approved course that is being received.
4. If appropriate, a shared Topics course may include pre- and co-requisites.

Process for entering pre- and co-requisites

1. Co-requisite: Enter the co-requisite as a co-requisite at the section level and then set the concurrent flag to YES.
2. Prerequisite: Enter the prerequisite as a co-requisite at the section level and then set the concurrent flag to NO.
