Eligibility Requirements:

- ✓ Enrolled in a South Dakota public university and classified as a sophomore, junior, or senior as of January 1, 2012.
- ✓ Have declared a major in a teacher education program.
- ✓ Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5 on a 4-point system.

A Complete Application Requires:

- ✓ A completed Haines Scholarship application;
- ✓ A typed resume;
- ✓ A typed statement describing your personal philosophy;
- ✓ A typed statement describing your philosophy of education.

South Dakota Board of Regents Haines Memorial Scholarship

Background:

The Haines Memorial Scholarship is awarded each year to a student majoring in education at BHSU, DSU, NSU, SDSU or USD. The scholarship is awarded on a competitive basis and is non-renewable. The award is allocated to the university for disbursement to the student in two equal installments of \$1,075 during the Fall 2012 and Spring 2013 semesters. The recipient of the Haines Scholarship will be approved at the South Dakota Board of Regents meeting on March 28-29, 2011.

The Haines Scholarship was established by Douglas Fugitt in memory of his wife Dora Lee Haines and her three sisters. All four Haines sisters were teachers in one-room rural schools in Perkins and Corson counties of South Dakota.

Eligibility Requirements:

Eligibility for this scholarship is limited to S.D. public university students who:

- ✓ Are classified as sophomores, juniors or seniors by their institutions;
- ✓ Have a cumulative college grade point average of at least 3.5;
- ✓ Are majoring in a program that prepares teachers.

Application Materials:

An application for the Haines Memorial Scholarship must include:

- ✓ A completed Haines Scholarship Application form;
- ✓ A typed resume which includes:
 - graduating high school and high school activities, memberships and services
 - listing of university memberships, activities and significant services;
- ✓ A typed two-page double-spaced statement describing your personal philosophy;
- ✓ A typed two-page double-spaced statement describing your philosophy of education.
