SUBJECT: CIP Code 2010 updates

In September, AAC discussed the release by the National Center for Educational Statistics (NCES) of the 2010 Classification of Instructional Programs (CIP). The Council agreed that these proposed changes should be reviewed by MOCC with a request that recommended actions should be forwarded to AAC

The Classification of Instructional Programs is a list of instructional programs used by postsecondary institutions when reporting on completions by field of study. The 2010 CIP Website can be accessed on line at <http://nces.ed.gov/ipeds/cip2010>.

When developing the 2010 CIP, NCES focused on adding new instructional programs; CIP codes were only deleted in order to avoid duplication with newly added codes. The 2010 CIP contains approximately 350 new 6-digit CIP codes and 50 new 4-digit CIP codes. No new 2-digit CIP codes were added.

IPEDS keyholders and coordinators will begin using the 2010 CIP for the Completions survey in Fall 2010, which will collect awards and degrees conferred between July 1, 2009 and June 30, 2010. Fall 2010 enrollment for the 9 special fields of study reported by 4-year institutions will also use CIP 2010.

The Data Administrators from each university completed the CIP wizard provided by NCES to determine the updates for the system. RIS also queried courses and programs to verify any other CIPs that may have moved or were deleted.

The changes detailed in the attached table will need to be made. Those captured in the first section include the sets of changes that should be made because of a change to, deletion of or addition of a CIP code. If approved, these will be done as a series of batch changes by RIS.

The last set includes changes that are proposed by a university to better align courses and programs offered within the CIP code framework.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Approve the recommended system changes and institutional changes.

The requested changes include:
