7. Explanation of the Change:

SOCW 650 Practice Informed Quantitative Research is being replaced with an approved elective. The program is preparing practice licensed social worker and can benefit from an additional elective. This creates the opportunity for graduates to leave with additional practice knowledge, skills, and abilities. Secondly, the program can adequately instruct research knowledge, skills and abilities to students through one graduate level research course. As a result, we are seeking approval to change the name of SOCW 750 to Advanced Practice in Social Work Research. Thirdly, the addition of an elective, does allow room for all of our students to complete a 12 credit certificate program without having additional courses to complete.

SOCW 730 and SOCW 742. If you take a look at these two courses, they do resemble each other in certain aspects. As a result, our program is seeking approval to move SOCW 742 to an elective status and rename it SOCW 742 Advanced Practice in Administration and Supervision. For SOCW 730, we would rename the course to better reflect its curriculum to SOCW 730 Advanced Practice with Communities and Organizations.

To fill the open three credit course section, when removing SOCW 742, we are seeking approval to move SOCW 712 Advanced Practice in Child Welfare from an elective to a required course. This course adds depth to our curriculum and matched better with our program mission and goals.
