7. Explanation of the Change:

Doctor of Education Administration- Superintendent, is a 90-95 credit hours degree with a minimum of 60 credit hours beyond a conferred master's degree and a minimum of 30 credit hours beyond a conferred master's degree and specialist's degree. Most students are entering the program with a MA and Ed.S. degree in Educational Administration. However, an internship at the superintendent level is required for licensure in South Dakota, so we want to ensure that an internship at the superintendent level is required for this degree as this degree leads to superintendent licensure.
