University Summary

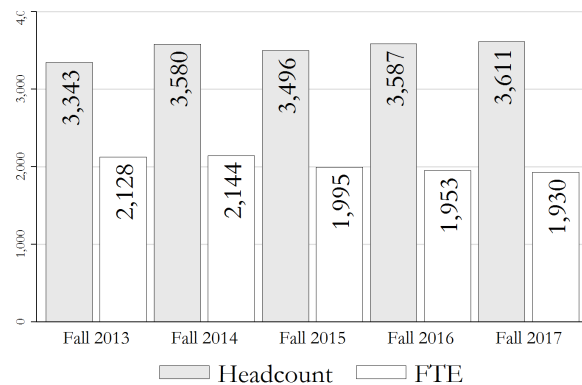
In Fall 2017, NSU reported a total headcount enrollment of 3,611 and a total full-time equivalent (FTE) enrollment of 1,930. Table 1 and Figure 1 show basic headcount and FTE figures for NSU over time.²

Enrollment by Student Characteristic

Table 2a splits NSU’s unduplicated headcount totals into two categories: (1) students taking at least one on-campus course from NSU, and (2) students taking off-campus courses from NSU only. Students taking a combination of on-campus and off-campus courses from NSU are included in the “On” category. Note that students reported in the “Off” category may have taken on-campus courses from other universities.

Detailed Enrollment by Location³

Table 7a provides an alternative representation of NSU headcount by location. In this table, students are duplicated by course location when applicable. However, the “All” column continues to show unduplicated headcount. As a result, percentage columns show each subgroup’s proportion of the total student population; these proportions will not sum to 100.0 percent.
