# Enrollment Book: NSU 2016

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Prepared by the SDBOR Office of Academic and Research Affairs, this report provides a compendium of data describing recent enrollment trends at Northern State University.<sup>1</sup> Identical reports are generated for each regental university, and are intended to serve as a resource for campus officials for planning and analysis purposes. 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### University Summary

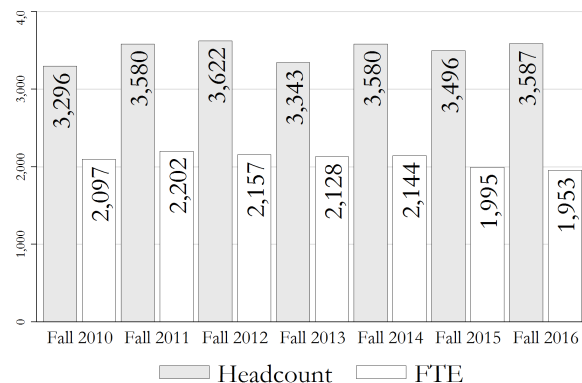
In Fall 2016, NSU reported a total headcount enrollment of 3,587 and a total full-time equivalent (FTE) enrollment of 1,953. Table 1 and Figure 1 show basic headcount and FTE figures for NSU over time.<sup>2</sup>

## Enrollment by Student Characteristic

Table 2a splits NSU’s unduplicated headcount totals into two categories: (1) students taking at least one on-campus course from NSU, and (2) students taking off-campus courses from NSU only. Students taking a combination of on-campus and off-campus courses from NSU are included in the “On” category. Note that students reported in the “Off” category may have taken on-campus courses from other universities.

## Enrollment by Student Characteristic (cont.)

## Detailed Enrollment by Location<sup>3</sup>

Table 7a provides an alternative representation of NSU headcount by location. In this table, students are duplicated by course location when applicable. For example, a student taking both an on-campus course from NSU and an off-campus course from NSU will be included in each respective column below. However, the “All” column continues to show unduplicated headcount. As a result, percentage columns show each subgroup’s proportion of the total student population; these proportions will not sum to 100.0 percent.
