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## SDBOR Custom Data Analysis

# Enrollment Book: USD 2016

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Prepared by the SDBOR Office of Academic and Research Affairs, this report provides a compendium of data describing recent enrollment trends at the University of South Dakota.<sup>1</sup> Identical reports are generated for each regental university, and are intended to serve as a resource for campus officials for planning and analysis purposes. 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### University Summary

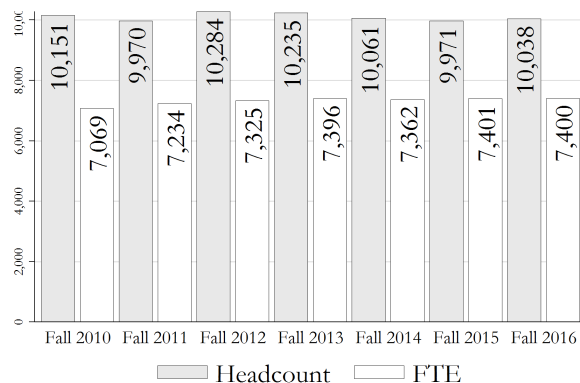
In Fall 2016, USD reported a total headcount enrollment of 10,038 and a total full-time equivalent (FTE) enrollment of 7,400. Table 1 and Figure 1 show basic headcount and FTE figures for USD over time.<sup>2</sup>

## Enrollment by Student Characteristic

Table 2a splits USD’s unduplicated headcount totals into two categories: (1) students taking at least one on-campus course from USD, and (2) students taking off-campus courses from USD only. Students taking a combination of on-campus and off-campus courses from USD are included in the “On” category. Note that students reported in the “Off” category may have taken on-campus courses from other universities.

## Enrollment by Student Characteristic (cont.)

## Detailed Enrollment by Location<sup>3</sup>

Table 7a provides an alternative representation of USD headcount by location. In this table, students are duplicated by course location when applicable. However, the “All” column continues to show unduplicated headcount. As a result, percentage columns show each subgroup’s proportion of the total student population; these proportions will not sum to 100.0 percent.
