SDSM&T Student Wins Scarborough Scholarship

PIERRE, S.D. – Kati Johnson, a chemical engineering major at South Dakota School of Mines and Technology has been awarded the Marlin R. Scarborough Scholarship by the South Dakota Board of Regents. The \$1,500 scholarship honors the late Marlin R. Scarborough, who was president of the Board of Regents at the time of his death.

The Scarborough Endowment Fund annually provides a scholarship to a student at a South Dakota public university. Applicants must have a 3.5 grade point average, demonstrate leadership potential, and be nominated by their university.

Johnson had a cumulative GPA of 4.0 after completing three semesters at South Dakota School of Mines and Technology. She is a graduate of Harding County High School, Buffalo, SD.
