1. The College Board (the administrators of the Advanced Placement [AP] program) is offering accommodations to students enrolled in AP coursework who experienced disruptions due to the COVID-19 crisis. The accommodations include modifications to traditional versions of AP exams.
2. The South Dakota Board of Regents and public university system shall accept AP credits earned during the Spring 2020 semester according to existing Board policies and Academic Affairs Council (AAC) guidelines. [Board Policy 2:5 - Transfer of Credit](#) and [AAC Guideline 7.5 - Advanced Placement](#) govern the acceptance of AP credits by the South Dakota Board of Regents and the public university system.
