### Registration and Course Attempts

#### *Temporary Policy Exceptions in Response to COVID-19*

**Date Issued:** April 16, 2020

**Universities:** Black Hills State University, Dakota State University, Northern State University, South Dakota School of Mines & Technology, South Dakota State University, University of South Dakota

1. [Board Policy 2:4 Registration](#) establishes the maximum number of times that students may attempt completion of a course for which credit is only counted toward graduation once.
2. **Undergraduate Students:** Students taking any course (course numbers 001-499) during the Spring 2020 semester shall not have the attempt counted against the maximum of three attempts established in Board Policy 2:4 (Section 1).
3. **Graduate Students:** Students taking any course (course numbers 500 and above) during the Spring 2020 semester shall not have the attempt counted against the maximum of two attempts established in Board Policy 2:4 (Section 2).
4. This temporary policy applies to all course attempts during the Spring 2020 semester, including transfer courses and attempts identified as “non-courses” in Board Policy 2:4 (e.g., CLEP, credit by exam).
