Maintenance & Repair Projects

Black Hills State University

Student Union Window and Door Hardware Replacement: This project involves bidding and construction south window replacement and replacing door hardware on all entries on the south and west side of the Student Union building at an estimated cost of \$95,000. Funding for the project will come GAF Bond Refunding.

Campus Bank Stabilization & Irrigation Ditch Replacement: This work request is for an additional \$90,000 for bank stabilization and landscape enhancement on state property adjacent to the Alumni Center building on BHSU's campus. The project includes regrading existing hillside for less slope; developing and constructing a bike & pedestrian pathway from St. Joe Street to campus center; and removing, redesigning and reconstructing existing irrigation channel; relocating utility infrastructure; and redesign and relocating emergency vehicle access on University Street adjacent to existing site. In June 2014, the Board approved using FY15 HEFF funds in the amount of \$289,687 for this project, and in December 2014, the Board approved using FY16 HEFF funds in the amount of \$450,000. The additional \$90,000 will be funded using university overhead.

South Dakota School for the Deaf

Mykleburst Recreation Facility Roof Replacement: This \$65,000 project is to remove roofing and limited asbestos material and install new rubber membrane. Funding for this project will come from rent revenue and lease payments.

South Dakota State University

Dykhouse Student Athlete Center: This \$90,000 project involves remodeling the former sports medicine suite into a student athlete academic student suite and converting the former agility training space into a football team room. This project is limited to interior remodeling and refinishing with minor mechanical and electrical construction. All design, materials, and labor will be provided by in-kind donations from a construction management firm.

SDSU will provide oversight to ensure compliance with life safety, design, and construction standards.

West Greenhouses Demolition: This project will remove three greenhouses, site utilities, foundations, and service tunnel. Demolition was authorized by the Board in October 2014 and by the South Dakota Legislature in the 2012 session. Funding for this \$80,000 project will come from pesticide application fees (AES).
