Olympus Confocol Microscope: This equipment, with a cost estimate of \$371,411.64, will be used in the Biomedical Engineering Program. The microscope will be used by both university and corporate researchers to visualize cell/material interactions. Funding for this purchase will come from FY15 Innovation Grant funds.

Maintenance & Repair Projects

Black Hills State University

Life Sciences Laboratory: This project involves design and installation of reused fume hoods to convert existing space to a research lab at an estimated cost of \$100,000. Funding for this project will come from residual FY14 HEFF project funds. Funding for this project will come from Institutional Overhead funds.

Entrance Sign: This project involves adding an entrance sign at the northeast corner of the BHSU campus property at an estimated cost of \$52,000. BHSU will utilize existing signage design for placement of this new entrance sign. The landscape around the sign will also be developed. Funding for this project will come from Institutional Overhead funds.

South Dakota State University

Agricultural Experiment Station Site Utility Improvements: This project involves improved utility access to the Cow Calf Unit along the north side of the SDSU campus at an estimated cost of \$65,000. The project includes connecting to the Northwestern Energy high pressure gas line, installation of a pressure reducing valve, connection to the Sioux Valley Energy three phase electrical power line, and installation of an electrical transformer. Funding for this project come from donations to AES through the SDSU Foundation. A funding guarantee letter is on file for this project.

Veterinary Isolation: This project involves demolition of the Veterinary Isolation Building at an estimated cost of \$70,000. The demolition was approved by the Board at their December 2014 meeting and approved through SB26 of the 2015 Legislative session. Asbestos containing materials will be removed from the building prior to demolition. Utilities (water, sewer, electrical, steam) will be terminated. Building, foundation, and interior equipment will be demolished and disposed of at a controlled landfill. The project will be completed by competitive proposal or professional services (asbestos abatement) and Facilities and Services maintenance personnel. Funding for this project comes from lab user fees.

Animal Science Complex Cooler Room & Labs: The estimated cost for this project's upgrades is \$95,000. This involves the full design and construction to subdivide room 148 into two rooms for laboratory support space for coolers/freezers dedicated to sample storage and bio-secure storage. Additionally, mechanical work is needed to connect biosafety cabinets in labs 144 and 149 and install electrical outlets in lab support room 137. The design will be completed by mechanical/electrical consulting engineers. Construction will be completed by SDSU Facilities and Services architectural staff, standing contracts for electrical and HVAC controls and complete proposals for HVAC and Electrical. SDSU Facilities and Services will manage the project. Funding for this work will come from current AES M&R funds and residual AES M&R funds.

Intramural Building Classroom Upgrades: This project upgrades Classroom 108 at an estimated cost of \$72,000. The upgrades include flooring, whiteboards, furnishings, repainting, wall protection, and lighting upgrades. Project design will be completed by SDSU Facilities and

Services engineering with construction being completed by SDSU Facilities and Services personnel. The SDSU Instructional Tech will upgrade the classroom technology. Furnishings will be procured by SDSU through approved state contract sources. Funding for this project will be \$40,000 in residual FY15 General M&R funds and \$32,000 in Student Fees.

Wintrode Student Success Center Classroom Upgrades: Classroom 188 will be upgraded at a cost of \$54,280. This project involves upgrades to flooring, ceiling, whiteboards, furnishings, repainting, acoustic, and lighting upgrades. SDSU Facilities and Services engineering will complete the design with contraction being completed by SDSU Facilities and Services personnel. The SDSU Instructional Tech will upgrade the classroom technology. Furnishings will be procured by SDSU through approved state contract sources. Funding for this project includes \$39,280 in residual FY15 General M&R funds and \$15,000 in Student Fees.
