BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION

Per BOR Policy, the Executive Director (or his/her designee) is granted authority to act on and/or authorize approval of various requests on behalf of the Board. In instances where these actions occur, the Executive Director shall provide to the Board a summary of these requests and approvals at each regularly scheduled Board meeting.

A portion of the interim actions of the Executive Director often include authorizing maintenance and repair projects submitted by the campuses whose costs range between \$50,000 and \$250,000 using institutional funds, donations, or funds not previously approved by the Board. Other finance-related action may also be the purchase of assets between \$250,000 and \$500,000 as well as any emergency approval of maintenance and repair projects.

IMPACT AND RECOMMENDATION

The list provided in Attachment I summarizes the interim actions taken by the Executive Director, or his designee.

INTERIM ACTIONS

Maintenance and Repair Projects

(\$50,000 - \$250,000)

Dakota State University

Heston Hall – Hydronic Heating/Cooling Systems Upgrade: Heston Hall’s main heating and cooling is through hydronic loops with fan coils in each space. Ventilation air is supplied by two air handling units which were replaced in 2015. The hydronic loop piping and fan coil units were installed in the early 1970’s and are in need of replacement. This work request was approved by the Board in December 2015 but an additional \$65,000 is needed; therefore, left over funds from the Trojan Field project is being reassigned to this Heston Hall project. An engineering firm will be hired to do the initial design work, prepare a cost estimate and develop of a phasing plan. Heston Hall is the administration building and will most likely phase construction a floor at a time due to its occupancy.

Northern State University

Barnett Center – Replace Floor Coverings: This project will replace all carpeted areas in the Barnett Center – concourse, hallways, offices and Hall of Fame room. It will also replace the ceramic tile in front of the concession stand with a more modern luxury vinyl tile. The \$150,000 needed for this project will come from the balance of HEFF funds remaining from the McWaldt Jensen heating and cooling project. The bids for the McWaldt Jensen project came in higher than anticipated so that project was scaled back leaving \$206,750 of unused HEFF funds. Some of those funds are now being used to renovate the Barnett Center.

South Dakota State University

Horticulture-Forestry Greenhouse – Controls Replacement: This project is for the full design and construction to replace the original pneumatic greenhouse controls with electronic controls controlled by a computer software system. The existing control system is obsolete and difficult to maintain. An electrical engineer consultant would design the project and provide plans and specifications. The project would be competitively bid and constructed by the lowest responsible bidder. A total of \$220,000 from pesticide fees (\$80,000) and greenhouse fees (\$140,000) will be used to purchase five (5) or six (6) of the total 14 greenhouse room controls that are planned for replacement during this phase.

Sundahl Apartments – Life Safety Upgrades: SDSU requests to upgrade the small wood-frame residential apartment house. Scope of this project will include installing egress windows in the basement-level apartment bedrooms, providing handrails and guardrails on interior and exterior stairs and landings, ceiling replacement, upgrade wall construction between apartment units to fire-rated construction, replace smoke detectors, install ground-fault interrupted outlets in kitchens and bathrooms, widen selected doorways accessing apartments, replace soffits, repaint exterior and interior, replace floor finishes,

install ventilation hoods over stoves, and widen exterior stair and roof canopy to basement access stair. SDSU facilities and services staff would provide necessary design assistance services and construction services. Some construction services may be provided through maintenance contracts. The cost of this project is estimated to be \$150,000 to be paid using rent revenues.

Dakota State University

HPE 3PAR Storage Area Network (SAN) Solutions: DSU requests to purchase a total of four (4) SAN units, two (2) for information technology services (ITS) production that will serve as redundant SAN units on campus, one (1) unit to reside at UC-SF for off-site storage, and one (1) unit that will reside in DSU’s Academic Information Assurance (Virtual IA) lab. Specific equipment includes three (3) HPE 3PAR 8400 All-in Multi Systems, and one (1) HPE MSA 2050 SAN which will reside at UC-SF. Funding for this \$387,000 equipment will come from computer science course delivery fees.

South Dakota State University

LogRhythm SIEM Solution: The Network and Security Group for the regental system recommended to the Technology Affairs Council (TAC) to purchase LogRhythm and make LogRhythm the system standard for security information and event management (SIEM). TAC also approved SDSU’s bid to serve as the shared service center for SIEM. The total cost for this new system-wide security standard is \$1,101,922.20 and will be phased in over the next four (4) years based on existing SIEM-related contract’s expiration date at each university. This cost will be split among the universities as follows:

As SDSU’s costs exceed \$250,000, approval of the Executive Director is needed. The initial cost of the LogRhythm solution is \$405,401.02 that will be paid for using student fees. SDSU staff and students will track security incidents and report back to the specific campus for resolution.

University of South Dakota

Cryogen-free Dilution Refrigerator System (Model BH-LD400): Radiation detection has broad importance to industry and science. Exquisite sensitivity to radiation is only possible by using detectors able to sense the smallest energy depositions. The most sensitive radiation detectors are operated at the coldest temperatures because the sensitivity increases very rapidly as the temperature decreases. As a result, the most sensitive detectors operate at cryogenic temperatures within a tenth of a degree of absolute zero. These temperatures can only be reached by a specialized fridge, a dilution refrigerator (DR) or an adiabatic demagnetization refrigerator (ADR). A DR is the only option that enables long-term radiation monitoring and taking science data including research and development, and attempting to make major physic discoveries. Dr. Sander and his Texas research collaborators have reached an agreement to fund this \$356,700 cryogen-free dilution refrigerator system. Dr. Sander secured a \$25,000 grant from the SDBOR Competitive Research Program, \$5,000 from Dr. Mei, and \$131,700 from Texas A&M University and the University of Texas. USD is contributing \$200,000 from indirect recovery costs from grants. A MOU between USD, Texas A&M, and the University of Texas has been agreed upon and signed by the authorized officers of all three institutions.

Clerical BOR Policy Updates

BOR Policy 5:5:2 Tuition and Fees: Off-Campus Tuition was updated on May 10, 2018, to reflect the following clerical errors (noted in red below):

A. PURPOSE

To establish the tuition structure for off-campus students; to document approved tuition reduction programs; and to delineate the distribution of tuition components.

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C. POLICY

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- 1.1. Standard Off-Campus Tuitions Rates: The Board sets tuition rates each spring that are effective for the following summer, fall and spring terms. This rate is comprised of the off-campus tuition rate plus an eleven and one-half percent~~er~~ (11.5%) Higher Education Facilities Fund (HEFF) component, and a surcharge for the support of the Electronic University Consortium (EUC).

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- 2.1. All off-campus tuition collected shall be deposited, 88.5% into the BOR system tuition fund and 11.5% into the Higher Education Facilities Fund.

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- 3.1. Reduced Tuition Benefit for South Dakota National Guard Members (SDCL §33-6-5): The undergraduate and graduate off-campus tuition rates assessed to

members of the South Dakota National guard may be reduced by the tuition benefit provided for on-campus courses, the ~~adjust being benefit will equal~~ one-half of the resident on-campus tuition rate. This benefit is applied after the federal tuition benefits and may not exceed 100% of the tuition costs.

BOR Policy 5:25 Auxiliary Revenue System was updated on May 10, 2018, to reflect the following clerical errors (noted in ~~red~~ below):

C. POLICY

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1.1 Construction Fund

All monies held in the construction fund shall be used or held for use solely for the payment of the cost of construction for the project(s) approved by the Board. The monies in the construction ~~fund~~ that are not needed for expenditures may be invested and reinvested in permitted investments. Interest from such investments prior to completion of the project(s), if the proceeds from the sale of the bonds plus earned interest exceed the cost of the project(s), shall be:

- Paid into the Bond and Interest Sinking Fund and used for the payment of the next interest payment of the bond, or
- Used for any purpose approved by the Board and bond counsel.

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2.4. Repair and Replace Reserve

On or before the close of each fiscal year, a minimum of 10% of the amount transferred to each Institution's Bond and Interest Sinking Fund shall be transferred from each institution's revenue fund to the RRR account until an amount equal to the RRR requirement of each institution has been accumulated. Transfers need not be made at any time when funds and investments in the RRR account exceed the RRR requirement. All moneys and investments held in the RRR shall be used and held for use to pay the cost of unusual or extraordinary maintenance or repairs, renewals, renovations and replacements, ~~and renovating~~ or replacement of furniture and equipment not paid as part of the ordinary maintenance and operation of the institutional system.

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5. Educating Staff Involved in Institutional System Reporting

Each institution's Chief Financial Officer will inform ~~their~~ ~~his/her~~ staff of the Board's policies and procedures for financial reporting of the Institutional System and monitor compliance.
