SUBJECT: Inactive Status and Program Termination Requests – SDSU

Consistent with their request to the Board of Regents to offer the Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA) in the areas of Architecture, Studio Art, Graphic Design, and Interior Design, South Dakota State University is asking that the five following degree programs be moved to inactive status. The current B.S. and/or B.A for each of these programs will be inactivated.

- Architectural Studies (B.S.)
Requested authorization to offer a BFA in Architecture which would serve as a replacement
- Art Education (B.A. and B.S.)
Requested authorization to offer a BFA in Studio Art with a Specialization in Art Education which would serve as a replacement
- Graphic Design (B.A. and B.S.)
Requested authorization to offer a BFA in Graphic Design which would serve as a replacement
- Interior Design (B.S.)
Requested authorization to offer a BFA in Interior Design which would serve as a replacement
- Studio Art (B.A. and B.S.)
Requested authorization to offer a BFA in Studio Art which would serve as a replacement

RECOMMENDED ACTION OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Approve SDSU's proposals to terminate the Architectural Studies (B.S), Art Education (B.A. and B.S.), Graphic Design (B.A. and B.S.), Interior Design (B.S.), Studio Art (B.A. and B.S.), Landscape Architecture (B.S.), and Pre-Family and Consumer Sciences programs.

Additionally, SDSU is seeking permission to offer the Bachelor of Landscape Architecture (BLA) to the recognized terminal degree list and including the BLA as an approved degree program offered through the Regental system. As a part of this process they are seeking to inactivate the B.S. in Landscape Architecture.

- Landscape Architecture (B.S.)
Requested authorization to offer a Bachelor of Landscape Architecture, a professional degree accredited by LAAB

Finally, SDSU is requesting that the Pre-Family and Consumer Sciences program code be removed from the recognized terminal degree table as the program has been inactivated.

The Pre-FCS designation is no longer used as a program code for admission to SDSU

The B.F.A. is to be a pre-professional degree in Architecture and when combined with the four semester Master of Architecture curriculum is the combined program in accreditation candidacy by the National Architectural Accreditation Board (NAAB). The pre-professional B.F.A. in Architecture would replace the equivalently pre-professional B.S. in Architectural Studies (CAS) that SDSU currently offers. The change in degree nomenclature helps graduates compete with professional peers at a regional and national level by utilizing a commonly recognized degree nomenclature for a pre-professional studio based architectural curriculum.
