Capital Asset Purchases Greater than \$250,000

South Dakota State University

BD FACSJazz (Becton-Dickinson Florescence-Activated Cell Sorting) System: This Chemistry/Biochemistry Department equipment will be used to sort and analyze cells. The cost for this item is \$283,150. The equipment is vital to establish the Imaging Core and High Content Facility of BioSNTR (Biochemical spatio-temporal NeTwork Resource). It will allow for state-of-the-art analysis of biochemical pathways within the BioSNTR ranging from cells of the immune system to cells that mediate nitrogen fixation in soybeans. Funding for this purchase will come from a National Science Foundation/EPSCoR grant funds.

Maintenance & Repair Projects

Black Hills State University

Electric Meter replacement: This project involves the design and installation of additional electric meters at an estimated cost of \$95,500. The new meters will be connected into the Building Automation System for accurate utility accounting. Funding for this project will come from previously approved FY15 HEFF M&R of \$58,608 plus an additional FY16 HEFF M&R residual funds.

Black Hills State University Center – Rapid City

Laboratory Fume Hood Installation: This project involves the installation of two fume hoods in existing laboratory space at an estimated cost of \$70,000. Funding for the project will come from a previously approved FY16 HEFF M&R Classroom Upgrade project for \$60,000 plus \$10,000 in residual FY15 HEFF M&R funds.

South Dakota State University

Hansen Hall Academic Evaluation and Assessment Testing Center Planning: This work request is for the programming, planning and design for a partial renovation in the basement level of Hansen Hall at an estimated cost of \$50,000. In the fall of 2015, the Academic Evaluation and Assessment Testing Center (AEA) will be moved from the SDSU Foundation Building. This project request will allow for the planning to move the renovation forward in the summer of 2015. Once the full scope of work is determined, a revised work request will be submitted. Funding for this planning project will come from FY12 HEFF M&R residual funds.

Harding Hall Renovation Space Study: This work order is for a space study in Harding Hall at an estimated cost of \$70,000. Architectural programming and a space study will be performed to determine the best use of available space and maintenance and repair needs. These services will assist SDSU in determining how best to renovate Harding Hall in the future.

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Funding for this portion of the project will come be \$10,000 from FY12 HEFF M&R residual funds and \$60,000 from FY15 HEFF M&R planning & design funds.

University of South Dakota

Wellness Center Electrical Feed: This project will refeed the Wellness Center into the campus electrical loop for an estimated cost of \$79,980. Funding for this project will come from USD Sales & Serves local funds.
